

3 Nights : The Best of Thevenard Island

Day 1: Arrival

Depart Onslow at 1.30pm and arrive to Thevenard Island after a 45-minute boat transfer from Onslow. Or catch a 30 minute scenic flight from Exmouth. The friendly island team will greet you upon arrival and show you to your self-contained cabin with stunning ocean views.

After settling into your cosy beachfront cabin, join us for Dinner Under the Stars to mingle with the other guests over a tasty meal. Use this opportunity to let us know what your island interests are and what tours you would like to participate in!

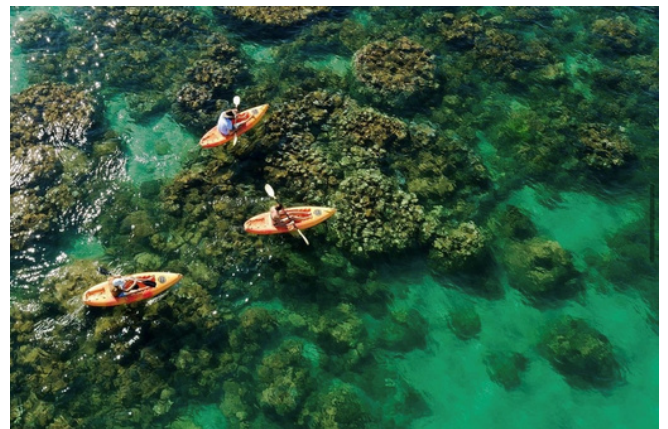


Day 3: Explore & Unwind

From Spanish Mackerel to Red Emperor to Giant Trevally and Mangrove Jacks, there is something for everyone!

For the afternoon you can hire a kayak, or stand-up paddle board, or snorkel set from our friendly island team and enjoy the sunshine and pristine waters. Or you can simply relax. Grab a book and take in the serenity from our beachfront hammocks or lie on the beach and keep an eye out for wildlife like dolphins and turtles.

Be sure to make the most of your last island sunset and watch an incredible canopy of stars flood the night sky.
